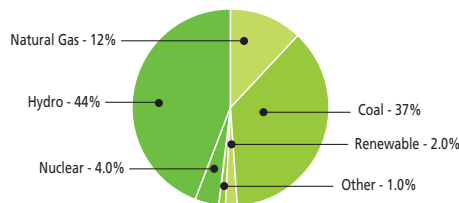


## Where does PGE get the renewable power?

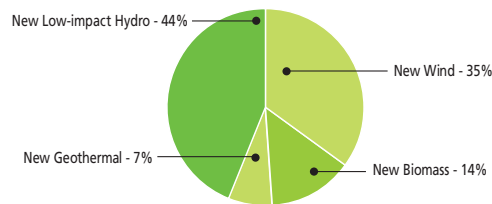
Power for the Green Source option comes from 100 percent new renewable energy sources.

In 2010, these sources included new wind, new biomass (wood waste), new geothermal and new low impact hydropower. Clean Wind and Green Source are generated from 100 percent new sources located in the Western Electricity Coordinating Council region.

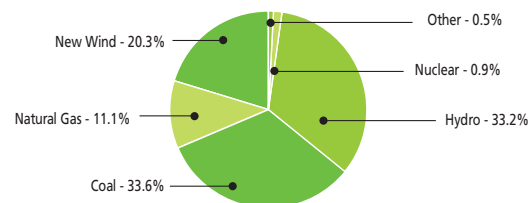
## Oregon Resource Mix

## Reduce your environmental impact

The average renewable power customer using 790 kWh monthly can offset over 8,550 lbs of CO<sub>2</sub> per year, which is the same as 9,503 miles not driven or planting 12.8 trees annually.

*Note:* Your chosen option will show up as a line item on your PGE bill once your enrollment form has been processed and your next meter read date has occurred.

## Frequently asked questions about renewable power.

**Q: Why are there special programs for renewable energy? Why isn't it just provided to everyone?**

**A:** While the price gap between renewable energy and conventional generation is narrowing, renewables are still more expensive than Basic Service power. PGE is supporting more wind projects all the time, and customer participation supports bringing additional renewables on-line. Oregon Senate Bill 1149, passed in 1999, requires us to offer three renewable options.

**Q: Is there a governing body that oversees PGE's renewable power transactions?**

**A:** Yes. The Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) approved all of our renewable power options. Prior to approval, PGE was required to submit a full description of these programs, including fund allocations. PGE submits annual reports on program administration and marketing for these programs, which are on file with the OPUC. PGE does not profit from the sale of these renewable energy options.

**A:** Green Mountain Energy Company ([www.greenmountain.com](http://www.greenmountain.com)) was selected in a competitive process to help PGE offer renewable products through 2012.

# Easy renewable choices

Both of these options are available to residential and small business (Schedule 32) customers and are as reliable as your current service.\*

Green Source is based on matching 100 percent of your actual energy use with renewable power; with Clean Wind, you purchase small units of renewable energy for a set fee. With both options, your standard usage is billed at the Basic Service or Time of Use rate and you pay an additional charge for the renewable option you choose. No matter which option you select, you will continue to receive the same reliable PGE electricity service. The table below explains the features and benefits of each option.

<b>Green Source</b> All of the energy you pay for is from 100% new renewable sources.	100% renewable power from renewable sources	100% of your monthly usage is offset with renewable resources	Your regular PGE energy rate plus an additional \$0.012 per kWh. <b>Clean Wind</b> Help build new renewable resources in Oregon, like the Solar Pioneer project that made our Capitol building the first in the U.S. to be illuminated by solar power.	100% renewable power from new wind	Available in 200 kWh units (each unit represents about 25% of your monthly usage**)	Your regular PGE energy rate plus an additional \$3.50 per 200 kWh unit – you can purchase as many units as you wish.

\*You will not have electricity from a specific generation facility delivered directly to your house, but the amount of electricity you consume will be replaced in the Western power grid by new renewable energy.
